Dear Parent or Guardian:

1. All medicine must be brought to school by an adult with proper medication orders filled out at the beginning of every school year. If a medication the student can carry on self is prescribed, med needs to be documented and approved by Provider and Parent or Guardian. Not all medication is self carry, only the ones for chronic problems.
2. Prescription medicine must be in a container with the pharmacy label for that student with specific instructions of time and dosage and must be brought to school by Parent/ Guardian. All non-prescription medication must be brought by an adult in a sealed unopened container with the approved documentation from Provider and Parent/Guardian. This includes Tylenol; Advil, cough drops, antihistamines, etc.
3. If your child has a chronic problem and needs medication throughout the year, new documentation is required at the beginning of school every year. New medication is also required. Old medication can be picked up through June of the previous school year and new documentation can be picked up at the same time.
4. Medications prescribed to be given three times a day or less are not to be given at school unless a specific time is prescribed by a health care provider, or the school nurse determines that a special need exists for an individual student.
5. No student may have prescription or non-prescription drugs in their possession on school grounds during school hours without proper authorization.
6. No employee of the school can accept any medication from a student, must be brought by Parent/Guardian to the nurses office.

These restrictions are necessary for protection of the health and safety of your child. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
