

Bruceville – Eddy ISD Fan and Spectator Behavior Policy

All Administrators for UIL sanctioned sports from BEISD and all District and Non-District ISD's will be following the "Behavior Expectations of Spectators" as set forth in the guidelines of the UIL. This includes administrator designees as assigned by BEISD administrators or by UIL member institutions.

Your support of Bruceville-Eddy ISD Athletics is appreciated. Let's conduct ourselves in such a way to bring dignity and respect to the Bruceville-Eddy community as a whole.

1st Offense: Any spectators ask to leave by an administrator (or his/her designee) from BEISD or any other school hosting a UIL sanctioned sporting event will be suspended from all BEISD athletic events, at home and on the road for 30 calendar days. During that period you will be required to meet with Superintendent and/or Principal before returning to athletic events. This includes ejections initiated by game officials.

2nd Offense: Will be subject to Suspension from all athletic events for 150 days. This may carry over into the next school year, if the suspension takes place within 150 days of the end of the school year. Example, suspensions taking place in softball or baseball season. During this period you will be required to meet with the Superintendent and/or Principal before returning to Athletic Events. This includes ejections initiated by game officials.

3rd Offense: Will be subject to Suspension for a full calendar year. During this period you will be required to meet with the Superintendent and/or Principal before returning to Athletic Events. This includes ejections from game officials.

** An incident involving threats, physical altercations or deemed "severe" by said administrator could result in suspension for a full calendar year.
