

BRUCEVILLE-EDDY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL SYSTEM

Dear Parent or Guardian:

There has been a change made by the Texas Legislation in a special meeting this summer. A new bill passed and implemented September 1 2017 is about notifying classes about nits(eggs) or live lice being found on a student in their class. Since most all of our grades change classes everyone in their grade will be sent a letter home with this information within five days of the finding. This is a new Texas law, not a Bruceville-Eddy Independent School system change in policy.

To avoid an infestation of lice, you should check your child daily for 10-14 days or once weekly. Remind your student that lice can be transmitted to another by touching heads, sharing clothes, or sharing combs or brushes. Be diligent in your treatment, if lice or nits are found on your student.
